

Downtown Redmond Link Extension

About the project

The Downtown Redmond Link Extension builds new light rail from the Redmond Technology Station, opening in 2023*, to Downtown Redmond by 2024*. Light rail will travel along SR 520 with stations at Marymoor Village and in Downtown Redmond.

Project benefits


- > 3.4 miles of new light rail with two new stations.
- > 1400 parking stalls at Marymoor Village Station.
- > Fast and reliable service with four-car trains every eight minutes during peak hours.
- > Direct service to Overlake, Bellevue, Mercer Island, downtown Seattle, the University of Washington, Northgate and Lynnwood.

What's happening now

Sound Transit's design-build team has completed 100% of the designs and construction is well underway. The focus is connecting the future 2 Line north from Redmond Technology Station to Downtown Redmond.

Through 2022 and 2023, construction will focus on the alignment along SR 520, upgrading the interface of SR 520 and SR 202/Redmond Way and completing the elevated guideway that will bring light rail to Downtown Redmond.


