Small Business	Small Business will be presumed if the business falls within one of the following categories: 1) Is certified by the Washington State Office of Minority and Women Business Enterprise (OMWBE) as SBE, DBE, MBE, WBE, MWBE, or SEDBE. To obtain a listing of firms certified by OMWBE, contact OMWBE at (360)-664-9750 or access a listing at: https://omwbe.wa.gov/certification 2) Is certified by King County's SCS program, whereupon the Small Business Administration small business standards are a criterion.
Medium Business	An entity that, together with its Affiliates, if any: (i) has (A) fewer than 250 employees, or (B) annual gross receipts of at least \$37 million but not more than \$250 million (averaged over the previous three years); and (ii) does not meet the requirements of a Small firm
Large	Any entity not covered by above defintions of micro, small, or medium.

Evironmental Services, A/E and PMCM) will each have a small firm, medium firm and large firm bench. Each MATOC prime can also add subconsultants as needed depending on the services sought via a RFTOP. The MATOC procurement program will provide a lot of opportunities for all size firms.

Sound Transit anticipates awarding several contracts per MATOC discipline (e.g. Environmental Services, A/E and PMCM) and per each bench (e.g. small firm, medium firm and large firm) within each MATOC discipline. Once MATOC benches are established, RFTOP could be issued to one or more firms qualified to provide the requested services, on one or more benches. Proposals received will then be evaluated and scored to determine the sucessful proposer for the service that is the subject of the RFTOP.
