Contract Modification with HNTB Corporation for Design-Build Project Management services for the Puyallup Station Parking and Access Improvement Project

Proposed action

Authorizes the chief executive officer to increase the contract contingency for the Puyallup Station Parking and Access Improvement project contract with HNTB Corporation in the amount of \$609,000, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$9,505,552, contingent upon Board approval of the Proposed 2022 Budget Amendment for Puyallup through Resolution No. R2022-10.

Key features summary

- This action increases the contract capacity with HNTB for design build project management services, allowing for HNTB to provide services through the completion of the project. The increase in contingency is contained within a Proposed 2022 Budget Amendment, that will be considered separately as Resolution No. R2022-10.
- HNTB Corporation currently provides design build project management (DBPM) services to the Puyallup Station Parking and Access Improvements project, this includes providing quality, safety, scheduling, and environmental oversite, as well as providing support with multiple agency agreements.
- The extended timeline to complete the project traffic mitigation improvement work has lengthened the period of performance for the DBPM services for Puyallup Station Parking and Access Improvement and increased the management costs for the DBPM contract.
- Extended performance period and additional oversight cost are related to various issues, including changes to traffic signalization at 4th and 7th Street; BNSF requirements for 5th and 7th Street rail crossings; and supply chain issues obtaining street lights and signal materials.

Background

In July 2019, Sound Transit executed a contract with HNTB Corporation for Auburn, Kent, Puyallup and Sumner Stations Parking and Access Improvement Project Design Build Project Management (DBPM) services.


The initial contract was authorized under the authority of Sound Transit's chief executive officer in the amount of \$4,899,552 (including 10 percent contingency) that represented the authorization for Phase 1B and Phase 2 for the Puyallup Station Parking and Access Improvement project. The contract

included multiple options for DBPM services for Kent, Auburn and Sumner Station Parking and Access Improvement Projects.

On February 13, 2020, Sound Transit executed a contract modification, authorized by Motion No. M2020-15, to exercise contract options with HNTB Corporation for DBPM services for the Kent and Auburn Stations Parking and Access Improvement projects in the amount of \$3,633,637, with a 10 percent contingency of \$363,363, totaling \$3,997,000, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$8,896,552.

This action would add contingency for the Puyallup Station Parking and Access Improvement project scopes of work only.

Project status



Projected completion date for Construction: Q4 2022

Procurement information

Request for Qualifications (RFQ) was advertised in December 2018 to procure a Design Building Project Management (DBPM) consulting firm to manage the Auburn, Kent, Sumner and Puyallup Parking & Access Improvement Projects. Four Statements of qualification (SOQ) were received January 31, 2019. The SOQ were evaluated and determined three of the firms would move to the interview phase of the procurement. After all three firms were interviewed it was determined the highest ranking firm was HNTB. Negotiations were completed in May 2019 and a Notice of Intend to Award was issued.

Sound Transit executed DBPM Contract RTA/AE 0613-18 with HNTB Corporation in July 2019, in the amount of \$4,454,138 for the scope of work for Puyallup Parking & Access Improvement project. The contact includes contract options for DBPM services for the Sumner, Kent, and Auburn Station Parking and Access Improvement Projects. The contingency requested will be applied to the Puyallup scope only, to address extended duration and any other changes to the contract. The parties will negotiate modifications to the Puyallup scope and issue contract modifications related to the duration and Puyallup scope of work upon reaching agreement on fair and reasonable amounts.

Fiscal information

Upon Board approval of the budget amendment through Resolution No. R2022-10, the authorized project allocation for the Puyallup Station Parking and Access Improvement Project is \$82,350,000.

This action is within the revised authorized project allocation and sufficient monies remain after approval of the action to fund the remaining work in the construction services.

Within the construction services phase, \$5,509,000 has been allocated to Design-Build Project Management (DBPM). The action would commit an additional \$609,000 of contract contingency with HNTB Corporation for DBPM services and leave a budget balance of \$448.
