Motion No. 3

A motion of the Board of the Regional Transit Authority for the Pierce, King and Snohomish Counties region formally appointing a committee to advocate support of and a committee to advocate rejection of the proposed Phase I system ballot proposition, to be voted on March 14, 1995.

Background:

For local jurisdiction ballot propositions, RCW 29.181.080 requires that the legislative body responsible for proposing a ballot proposition shall appoint, no later than 45 days before the election, a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection. The Board may appoint three persons to each committee, who respectively are known to support or oppose the proposition.

As required by local election rules, the RTA published notice 50 days in advance of the election that it would appoint persons to these committees on January 27, 1995 at its regularly scheduled Board meeting, and requested interested persons to notify the Board Administrator if they wished to serve.

The Pierce County Auditor, the King County Records and Elections Manager, and the Snohomish County Auditor have agreed to publish and distribute a single voter pamphlet within the RTA district, and the King County Elections Manager is coordinating the voter pamphlet publication and distribution. The election officials will work with the committees to develop the pro and con statements for the voter pamphlet.

Motion:

It is hereby moved that the Board of the Regional Transit Authority appoint the individuals listed on Attachment A to the committees as shown, and that the Executive Director give appropriate notification to the King County Records and Elections Office of the appointment of said committees and their members.
