OBJECTIVE OF ACTION

To provide engineering services for the Tacoma Link Light Rail and Tacoma Maintenance Facility construction contracts.

ACTION

Authorizes the Executive Director to execute a contract amendment with Otak to provide engineering services for the Tacoma Link Light Rail and Tacoma Maintenance Facility construction contracts in the amount of \$400,000 with a 10% contingency of \$40,000, for a total authorization amount not to exceed \$440,000 and for a total contract amount of \$4,325,671.

KEY FEATURES

This action authorizes Otak to continue engineering services in support of construction management and allow the contractors to resolve field issues related to the design on both the Tacoma Link Light Rail and Maintenance Facility construction projects. Engineering services during construction are needed to expedite resolution in the following:

- Engineering support of unanticipated field conditions with existing and proposed utilities within the trackway right of way
- Engineering review of submittals by the contractor
- Engineering response to requests for information (RFIs)
- Engineering support of ongoing negotiations with public and third party utilities
- Coordination of effects of engineering changes to the 910 construction contract on all other Tacoma construction contracts
- Engineering support in the determination/resolution of changed field conditions
- Preparation of engineering change orders
- Revisions of Contract Documents
- Revisions of Technical Specifications
- As-built CAD support
- Change Order CAD support
- Railroad Engineering
- Traffic Engineering
- Support in resolution of claims

Highlights of Action:

- Provides engineering services for the Tacoma Link Light Rail and Tacoma Maintenance Facility construction contracts.
- Authorizes the Executive Director to execute a contract amendment with Otak to provide engineering services during construction in the amount of \$400,000 with a 10% contingency of \$40,000, for a total authorization not to exceed \$440,000 and for a total contract amount of \$4,325,671.

History of this Contract

Otak's original contract for engineering services during design and construction of Tacoma Link Light Rail was approved by M99-26 by the Finance Committee on June 17, 1999. During contract negotiations for this original contract, a place holder of \$128,969 for Bid and Construction support services was established, because at that time the exact scope of overall services was undefined. Staff expected to utilize the \$128,969 to bid and award the construction contracts and to begin construction within the engineering services scope of the original contract and then go back to the Finance Committee for approval of additional funds once a more detailed project scope and schedule was determined.

Otak began providing these bid services in June 2000 when Sound Transit advertised for the Tacoma Link Light Rail Line and Tacoma Maintenance Base construction contracts. Sound Transit has currently expended the original allocation of \$128,969 for the bidding and awarding phases of this project, as included in the original contract. Staff now has a detailed scope and schedule of engineering services for the remainder of the construction phase, and is requesting additional funds to support the 21 month construction contract of the Tacoma Link Light Rail.

Funding for this scope of work is included in Sound Move and in the FY2001 adopted capital budget. The budget for completion of these tasks is identified in Sound Transit's Adopted 2001 Budget construction for Tacoma Link (page 133). Total construction for Tacoma Link is budgeted at \$48,374,000. The budget shortfall of \$440,000 on this contract can be covered by the \$4,023,329 budget surplus gained from the Tacoma Link Light Rail construction contract (Motion 2000-114, as adopted by the Board on Feb. 8, 2001). With the budget developed for the Tacoma Link configuration as adopted by the Board, there is sufficient funding to complete the remaining work.

CONSEQUENCES OF DELAY

Delay in approving this contract amendment would delay necessary reviews of contract submittals and requests for information by the contractor.
