OBJECTIVE OF ACTION

• To extend an existing sole source contract to McBee Strategic for federal relations consulting services for an additional three-month period from October 1, 2002 until December 31, 2002.

ACTION

 Authorizes the Executive Director to extend an existing sole source contract with McBee Strategic for federal relations consulting services for an additional three-month period from October 1, 2002, until December 31, 2002, in the amount of \$45,000 for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$135,000.

KEY FEATURES

- This proposed sole source extension would preserve the services of McBee Strategic
 through the end of 2002 during a critical juncture in the agency's federal partnership. During
 the fall of 2002, Sound Transit will competitively procure federal relations consulting services
 prior to expiration of the McBee Strategic and the other Sound Transit federal relations
 contracts. Staff intends to have a new contract or contracts in place by January 1, 2003.
- Provides continuity in Sound Transit's federal relations at a critical juncture in the agency's federal partnership. During the last quarter of the year, the 107th Congress will finish work on the FY 2003 transportation appropriations bill and the federal Full Funding Grant Agreement for the Initial Segment of the Central Link Light Rail project will be continuing through the federal approval process.
