A motion of the Board of the Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority authorizing Board member(s) to travel to the Rail-Volution 2002 Conference being held in Washington D.C. from October 3, 2002, through October 6, 2002.


Background:

Resolution No. 98-7, adopted April 9, 1998, establishes Sound Transit's travel and reimbursement policies. Under that Resolution, travel by board members "...on behalf of the Authority beyond a radius of 300 miles from the Authority or which requires overnight lodging shall be approved by the Board's Executive Committee." Approval of this motion would authorize Board member(s) to attend the Rail-Volution 2002 Conference.
