MOTION NO. M2003-30

A motion of the Executive Committee of the Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority authorizing Board members Mark Olson and Dave Enslow to travel to San Francisco, California, for a field study of the Smart Card system.

Background:

Resolution No. 98-7, adopted April 9, 1998, establishes Sound Transit's travel and reimbursement policies. Under that Resolution, travel by board members "...on behalf of the Authority beyond a radius of 300 miles from the Authority or which requires overnight lodging shall be approved by the Board's Executive Committee." Approval of this motion would authorize Board members Mark Olson and Dave Enslow to travel to San Francisco, California, for a field study of the Smart Card system.
