OBJECTIVE OF ACTION

To amend the existing sole source contract with Moss Adams Associates to continue the accounting support services until the completion of the recruitment for an Accounting Manager, bridging the staff vacancy created by the departure of the manager responsible for the Treasury Division.

ACTION

Authorizing the Executive Director to execute a contract amendment with Moss Adams Associates to continue to provide accounting support services in the amount of \$80,001 for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$180,000 and extending the contract date from May 31, 2003 to July 31, 2003.

KEY FEATURES

- Authorizes the Executive Director to execute a contract with Moss Adams Associates to
 provide accounting support services for the Accounting and Treasury Division for an amount
 not to exceed \$80,001, with a new total contract amount not to exceed \$180,000.
- Scope includes support and guidance of accounting and treasury staff as assigned, including but not limited to payroll, accounts payable, accounts receivable, cash collections, general ledger, regional fare integration and revenue staff. In addition, special projects have been assigned related to the OneWorld software modules for payroll and human resources.
- Provides for timely support of the Controller, Chief Financial Officer and Deputy Chief Financial Officer, including, but not limited to, the month-end close of the general ledger and production of the month-end financial reports, and assisting the Budget Division in the analysis of month-end variances.

- Given the complex nature of the agency's accounting and financial information systems,
 Moss Adams is uniquely suited to providing these services due to past assistance related to
 the OneWorld system implementation as well as year-end accounting support. This
 knowledge is especially invaluable given the departure of a key manager and a number of
 new staff members within the Accounting and Treasury Division, reducing the risk of major
 omission or error.
- The year-end and state audits required a substantial level of effort, such as preparation and review of working papers and significant year-end analysis support. With the successful completion of these audits, the recruitment is now moving forward and should be completed by July 31, 2003.
