OBJECTIVE OF ACTION

 To provide design support during construction for Contract C700 (Royal Brougham Way to Airport Way South).

ACTION

 Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to execute a contract amendment with Huitt-Zollars, Inc. to provide design support during construction for Central Link Initial Segment Construction Contract C700 – Royal Brougham Way to Airport Way South, in the amount of \$476,200, with a contingency of \$47,620, for a total of \$523,820 and for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$3,787,421.

KEY FEATURES

- Bid-opening for construction Contract C700 Royal Brougham Way to Airport Way South (RTA/LR 39-02) occurred on June 12, 2003.
- Upon execution of the Full Funding Grant Agreement from the Federal Transit Administration, the C700 construction contract will be awarded.
- Huitt-Zollars, Inc. is the Civil Facilities Final Design Consultant for design Contract D700. To
 prepare for the construction phase, staff is now recommending a contract amendment with
 Huitt-Zollars, Inc. to provide design support during construction. The construction duration
 for C700 is approximately 26 months (fall 2003 to fall 2005).

BUDGET IMPACTS SUMMARY

There are no budget impacts for this action.

BUDGET DISCUSSION

The action considered by this motion will authorize the addition of \$523,820 to the contract with Huitt-Zollars, Inc., to provide design services during construction for C700, and yield a potential expenditure amount for the contract not to exceed \$3,787,421.

The total adopted capital budget for the Initial Segment is \$2.07 billion. Within that budget, \$550,000 has been authorized in the final design phase for design services during construction for C700. Should the proposed action be approved, \$26,180 will remain unallocated for this budget item.

REVENUE, SUBAREA, AND FINANCIAL PLAN IMPACTS

The proposed action is covered by the current Board adopted budget, and is affordable within the agency's current long-term financial plan and subarea financial capacity. The action will have no new revenue impacts on Sound Transit.

M/W/DBE - SMALL BUSINESS PARTICIPATION

Prime Consultant/Contractor

Huitt-Zollars' original M/W/DBE and Small Business commitment was 25 percent. They have currently achieved 24.6 percent. During execution of the project, a key W/DBE subconsultant (Symonds Consultants) was purchased by PACE, which is not a W/DBE or small business. Therefore, when PACE purchased Symonds, their subsequent work did not add to the M/W/DBE and small business count, although their participation continued on the contract.

A greater share of the budget in this amendment is directed toward the structural subconsultant (Inca) than other subconsultants on the Huitt-Zollars team. Therefore, the projected M/W/DBE and small business value for this amendment is 13.78 percent.

The total net projected M/W/DBE and small business participation on this contract, including this amendment, is 23.22 percent.

HISTORY OF PROJECT

Huitt-Zollars, Inc. is the final design consultant for design Contract D700 (Royal Brougham Way to Airport Way South). Sound Transit has opened bids for construction Contract C700, and plans to award the construction contract following execution of the Full Funding Grant Agreement. Staff anticipates the start of construction in the fall of 2003. To provide design support during the construction phase, it is standard practice for the final designer to be available. The types of tasks the final designer performs during construction include: review of shop drawings, review of temporary shoring designs, review of contractor Requests for Information, resolution of construction issues which affect the final design, review and response to contractor Value Engineering proposals, etc. The scope of design support during construction will be in effect during the anticipated construction period, from fall 2003 through fall 2005.

CONSEQUENCES OF DELAY

Award of Construction Contract C700 is anticipated in September 2003. Immediately upon award, the contractor will begin to fulfill contract requirements for providing detailed construction submittals. These technical submittals, such as material specifications, shop drawings, catalog cut sheets, shoring designs and others, will require review and concurrence by the designers. In addition, formal value engineering proposals made by the contractor must be reviewed in detail by the designers. Since one of the first activities of the contractor is the start of the provision of technical submittals, it is important that the design support team be available soon after contract award. Delay in approval of this contract amendment for design support during construction, beyond the timeframe for award of the construction contract, would delay the ability of Sound Transit to respond to contractor submittals in a timely manner. Delay in response to contractor submittals could result in contractor claims for additional time to complete the construction.
