Report of the Chair

Mr. Ladenburg announced that the Board would convene an Executive Session following the action items. He advised that there would not be any action taken following the Executive Session.

Chief Executive Officer Report

Ms. Earl presented the first quarter 2004 ridership report. She stated that systemwide, ridership was up 23.1% over first quarter 2003; without the addition of Tacoma Link, ridership was up 13.5% from first quarter 2003.

Ms. Earl advised the Board that she announced a staff reorganization earlier in the week and explained the changes.

She asked Mr. Ahmad Fazel, Director of Link Light Rail, and Mr. Martin Schachenmayr, Link Project Control Manager, to give an update on the steel prices (copy on file).

Motion No. M2004-44 – Directing staff to continue advancing the South Everett Freeway Station/112th Street SE project and resolve the funding shortfall following completion of preliminary engineering and environmental documentation, final design, and further negotiations with the City of Everett

It was moved by Mr. Olson, seconded by Ms. Marshall, and carried by the unanimous vote of all Board members present that Motion No. M2004-44 be approved as presented.

Motion No. M2004-51 — Authorizing the Chief Executive Officer to execute a contract amendment with Hatch Mott MacDonald/Jacobs Joint Venture to provide civil engineering design services during construction, including engineering oversight services for the sequential excavation work for the Beacon Hill Tunnel in the Central Link Light Rail Initial Segment Project in the amount of \$5,580,000 with no contingency for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$18,668,763

It was moved by Mr. Crawford, seconded by Ms. Thomas, and carried by the unanimous vote of all Board members present that Motion No. M2004-51 be approved as presented.

At 1:55 p.m. the Board convened a 30-minute executive session to discuss with legal counsel potential litigation to which Sound Transit is likely to become a party.
