ACTION

Approve the appointment of two new Citizen Oversight Panel members, Aubrey Davis and Patsy Tsui Bonincontri, both of the East King County subarea for a term of four years, beginning November 2004 and expiring November 2008. These new appointments are to replace two former members who resigned their terms in August, 2004.
