PROJECT NAME

Central Link Light Rail Initial Segment

PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the Chief Executive Officer to execute a contract amendment with AMEC Earth and Environmental, Inc. to provide special inspection services for the Central Link Light Rail Initial Segment, Boeing Access Road to South 154th Street, in the amount of \$298,772, plus a contingency of \$45,228, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$3,165,170.

Original contract:

 Provided geotechnical design and construction management engineering services for Central Link Light Rail Initial Segment, Boeing Access Road to South 154th Street.

This contract amendment:

• Provides special geotechnical inspections as required by City of Tukwila building permit conditions. These inspections are required on deep shafts, retaining walls, soil nail walls, structural fills, mechanically stabilized earth (MSE) retained fills, and pile installations.

BUDGET and FINANCIAL PLAN DISCUSSION

The proposed action would authorize amendment of the contract with AMEC Earth and Environmental, Inc. to provide special inspection services for the Central Link Light Rail Initial Segment, Boeing Access Road to South 154th Street, in the amount of \$344,000, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$3,165,170.

The total adopted capital budget for the Initial Segment is \$2.07 billion. Within that budget, \$350,000 has been set aside for the Geotechnical Package 4 (C755 Tukwila) in the construction services phase. Since that budget has been committed, approval of the proposed action would result in a budget shortfall of \$344,000 for this budget line item - the full amount proposed. Should the proposed action be approved, \$200,000 of the additional budget for these C755 geotechnical services would be funded from the surplus budget, and \$144,000 would be transferred from unallocated contingency within the construction services phase, leaving a remaining balance of \$2,091,084 in unallocated contingency.

The proposed action is consistent with the current adopted budget and is affordable within the agency's long-term financial plan and subarea financial capacity. The action will have no new revenue impact on Sound Transit.

M/W/DBE – SMALL BUSINESS PARTICIPATION

The initial M/W/DBE and small business commitment for this contract was 30.7%. To date the overall small business participation is 47.6%, of which M/W/DBE participation is 25.1%.

Because of the highly specialized nature of this work, approximately 3% of the work covered by the change will be performed by small business firms.

With this change order, overall small business participation is projected to achieve 47.5%, including M/W/DBE participation of 25.7%. Even though participation on this change order is relatively small, overall participation will exceed the original contract commitment. Sound Transit staff and AMEC continue to work to increase the small business participation levels for this contract.
