# PROJECT NAME

Sounder Commuter Rail - On-Call Rail Engineering Consulting Services

# PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a contract with HNTB Corporation to provide oncall rail engineering consulting services for Sounder commuter rail track and signal projects for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$500,000.

# KEY FEATURES of PROPOSED ACTION

- The contract scope of work also includes various railroad engineering services:
  - Railroad Engineering
  - Engineering Analysis
  - Independent Review
  - CADD Support Services
- This contract duration is for a two-year period from the Notice to Proceed.

# BUDGET IMPACT SUMMARY

There is no action outside of the Board-adopted budget; there are no contingency funds required, no subarea impacts, or funding required from other parties other than what is already assumed in the financial plan.

#### **BUDGET and FINANCIAL PLAN DISCUSSION**

The budget associated with railroad engineering consulting services work is contained within the preliminary engineering, final design, and construction phases of each capital project's budget; based on the project's anticipated need for such service. In addition, there are railroad

engineering consulting services work done within the operations group. This is an on-call contract to be used as the need arises.

The table below indicates where the contract funds are expected to be used, the budgets associated with those projects and programs, and the uncommitted funds for each.

There are sufficient funds to complete this action. Committing these funds will not endanger any other project elements that are to be funded out of the overall project.

## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION and BACKGROUND for PROPOSED ACTION**

The HNTB Corporation on-call railroad engineering contract will provide consultant services for railroad engineering, engineering analysis, independent technical review, and CADD support services for Sound Transit's commuter rail programs.

The contract with HNTB was competitively procured; three bids were received and a notice of selection was issued on August 20, 2007.

Staff anticipates the on-call railroad consultant will work on tasks over the next six to twelve months that may include: design work to add storage tracks to the L Street Layover Facility in Tacoma, conduct independent reviews of the final designs for M Street-to-Bridgeport track and signal and D-to-M Street track and signal projects and engineering analysis of the Sounder commuter rail operations along the Tacoma-to-Lakewood rail corridor.
