PROJECT NAME

Unarmed Security Services

PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a contract amendment with Securitas Security Services to provide unarmed security services in the amount of \$1,800,000, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$7,764,744.

KEY FEATURES of PROPOSED ACTION

- The scope of this contract includes unarmed security services for Sounder commuter rail, Tacoma Link, Sound Transit facilities and administration buildings.
- This action authorizes an additional \$1,800,000 for the second of two optional years, to extend the contract to August 31, 2008.

BUDGET IMPACT SUMMARY

There is no action outside of the Board-adopted budget; there are no contingency funds required, no subarea impacts, or funding required from other parties other than what is already assumed in the financial plan.

BUDGET and FINANCIAL PLAN DISCUSSION

The proposed action would exercise a one-year extension of the contract with Securitas to provide unarmed security services at various facilities for Sound Transit, during the period from September 1, 2007 to August 31, 2008.

Funding for these services for the period through December 2007 is included in the Adopted 2007 Budget with a total for all agency safety and security services of \$3.2 million. The 2007 budget included \$2,037,533 for Sounder, \$561,133 for ST Express, \$312,533 for Tacoma Link, and \$334,000 for Union Station. From the inception of the contract through June 2007, a total of \$4,731,000 has been spent on these services. An additional \$1,234,000 is committed for future services. The remaining balance of the 2007 budget will be used to fund \$600,000 of the costs associated with this contract extension.

Budget authority for the 2008 portion of \$1,200,000 will be included within the Proposed 2008 Budget; among which, \$754,000 would be spent on Sounder, \$208,000 would be spent on ST Express, \$114,000 would be spent on Tacoma Link, and \$124,000 would be spent on Union Station.

BUDGET TABLE

The proposed contract amendment is funded through a combination of existing budgets from the Adopted 2007 Budget and the Proposed 2008 Budget. The impact of this contract on the current and proposed future budgets is illustrated below.

- 1 The total budget for Sounder Safety and Security is \$2,038K; this budget is found on page 55 of the Adopted 2007 Budget book. The total budget for ST Express Safety and Security is \$561K; this budget is found on page 59 of Adopted 2007 Budget book. The total budget for Tacoma Link Safety and Security is 312K; this budget is found on page 51 of the Adopted 2007 Budget book. The total budget for TSD Staff Services is \$1,741K, of which \$334K is related to Safety and Security at Union Station; this budget is found on page 201 of the Adopted 2007 Budget book.
- 2 Represents the amount to be spent at the end of the current contract. The amount for Sounder would be \$775K, for ST Express would be \$213K, for Tacoma Link would be \$119K and for Union Station would be \$127K.
- ³ This contract would add \$1,800K to the current contract for the period ending August 31, 2008. The remaining spending for the current year for Sounder would be \$377K, for ST Express would be \$104K, for Tacoma Link would be \$57K and for TS would be \$62K.
- ⁴ Represents the amount expected to be included in the 2008 transit operations budget for Safety and Security.
- This amount would be available to fund the remaining balance of the proposed contract.

SMALL BUSINESS PARTICIPATION

Proposers were not asked to prepare a plan for the participation of M/W/DBE or other small businesses as subcontractors. It was determined that subcontracting was not feasible as it was not in the best interest of Sound Transit to have more than one contractor to provide the services under the security contract.

Prime Consultant/Contractor

Securitas Security Services is the prime consultant for this contract.

EEO Commitment

The workforce for the Securitas Security Services is comprised of 16.9% minorities and 13.2% women.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION and BACKGROUND for PROPOSED ACTION

In 2005, Sound Transit conducted a competitive procurement process to select a firm to provide unarmed security services for Sounder commuter rail, Tacoma Link and Sound Transit parking garages, park-and- ride lots and administration buildings.
