PROJECT NAME

Agency-wide Heating, Ventilation, & Air Conditioning (HVAC) Maintenance

PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a contract with the McKinstry Company to provide agency-wide heating, ventilation, and air conditioning maintenance services for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$513,509.

KEY FEATURES of PROPOSED ACTION

- This action will provide Sound Transit the technical skills necessary to perform preventative maintenance and on-call services for all agency heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems.
- The contract scope of work with the McKinstry Company includes quarterly and annual maintenance as well as on-call services for HVAC systems at identified Sound Transit facilities. The contract provides for an initial inspection of listed equipment and a report documenting the condition of the equipment.
- The contract with the McKinstry Company provides for a one-year term with three additional one-year options to extend. The requested contract amount is for all four years of the contract.

BUDGET IMPACT SUMMARY

There is no action outside of the Board-adopted budget; there are no contingency funds required, no subarea impacts, or funding required from other parties other than what is already assumed in the financial plan.

BUDGET and FINANCIAL PLAN DISCUSSION

Funding for these services for the period through December 2007 is included in the Adopted 2007 Budget with a total for all agency facility related maintenance of \$3.6 million. The 2007 budget included \$1,156,990 for Sounder, \$1,272,051 for ST Express, \$413,712 for Tacoma Link, and \$720,997 for Union Station. Through September 2007, a total of \$1,308,000 has been spent and committed to all facility maintenance. The remaining balance of the 2007 budget will be used to fund \$33,000 for the services provided from October 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007.

Budget authority for the 2008 portion of \$481,000 will be included within the Proposed 2008 Budget; among which \$767,000 would be spent on Sounder, \$161,000 would be spent on ST Express, \$38,000 would be spent on Tacoma Link, and \$135,000 would be spent on Union Station.

BUDGET TABLE

The proposed contract will be funded through a combination of existing budgets from the Adopted 2007 Budget and Proposed 2008 Budget. The impact of this contract on the current and proposed future budgets is illustrated below.

- Represents the total of Station Maintenance budget, including spending on HVAC services, in the amount of \$3,564K. The total budget for Sounder Maintenance Stations is \$1,157K; this budget is found on page 55 of the Adopted 2007 Budget book. The total budget for ST Express Maintenance Stations is \$1,272K; this budget is found on page 59 of Adopted 2007 Budget book. The total budget for Tacoma Link Maintenance Stations is \$414K; this budget is found on page 51 of the Adopted 2007 Budget book. The total budget for TSD Staff Maintenance Services is \$1,741K; this budget is found on page 201 of the Adopted 2007 Budget book.
- ² Represents the amount to be spent at the end of the August 31, 2007 before the contract with McKinstry starts on September 1st, 2007. The amount for Sounder would be \$390K, for ST Express would be \$449K, for Tacoma Link would be \$109K and for Union Station would be 360K.
- 3 Represents the amounts would be spent in 2007 for this contract. The amount for Sounder would be \$10K, for ST Express would be \$11k, for Tacoma link would be \$3K, and for TSD Staff would be \$9K.
- 4 Represents the amount expected to be included in the 2008 and beyond for HVAC services for all current and future stations. This amount would be available to fund the remaining balance of the proposed four year contract.

The McKinstry Company is a privately held corporation and will perform 100% of the work.
