

MOTION NO. M2010-52

A motion of the Board of the Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority authorizing travel and approving payment of expenses for Board Chair Aaron Reardon to attend the Greater Seattle Chamber of Commerce Intercity Study Mission in Boston, MA from June 9 to June 11, 2010 on behalf of Sound Transit.

BACKGROUND:


Resolution No. 98-7, adopted April 9, 1998, establishes Sound Transit's travel and reimbursement policies. Under that Resolution, travel by Boardmembers "...on behalf of the Authority beyond a radius of 300 miles from the Authority or which requires overnight lodging shall be approved by the Board's Executive Committee." Approval of this motion would authorize Board Chair Aaron Reardon to attend the Greater Seattle Chamber Intercity Study Mission in Boston, MA.

This motion is being brought directly to the Board for action because travel needs to be arranged prior to the next Executive Committee meeting scheduled for May 6, 2010.
