PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a contract with Pease Construction, Inc. to construct certain layover facility improvements for the Lakewood Layover project in the amount of \$3,283,130, with a 10% contingency of \$328,313, for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$3,611,443.

KEY FEATURES

- The Lakewood Layover project will provide protected overnight parking for Sounder trains in Lakewood. The layover tracks were constructed as part of the M Street to Lakewood Track and Signal Project.
- Pease Construction, Inc., will construct the layover facility improvements including:
 - Lighting, fencing and two guard shacks for security
 - Wayside power for the six trainsets to be stored overnight.
 - Roads and walkways for the BNSF and Amtrak maintenance crews to provide access to the trains.
- The layover facility improvements are scheduled to be completed in the first quarter of 2013. The layover facility is sufficiently developed to support the start of Sounder service to Lakewood; completion of these improvements will make the facility fully functional.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Sounder service to Lakewood is scheduled to begin in fall 2012. The layover project is the last component of the Tacoma-to-Lakewood commuter rail extension to be constructed to support Sounder Operations. The layover is a system-wide component of the Sounder program that includes storage tracks and facilities for layover trains at Seattle, Everett, Tacoma, and Lakewood. The costs and budget are allocated to Snohomish, South King, and Pierce subareas based on track miles.

FISCAL INFORMATION

This action is within the adopted budget and sufficient monies remain after approval of this action to fund the remaining work in the Construction phase as contained in the current cost estimates.

BACKGROUND

Sound Transit is scheduled to begin Lakewood-to-Tacoma Sounder service in fall 2012. The M Street to Lakewood Track & Signal project was completed in 2010 which included the installation of tracks and switches within the layover yard. The D Street to M Street Track and Signal project is under construction and the contractor has turned the completed track over to Sound Transit to begin testing, commissioning, and training in support of the start of revenue service this October. The Lakewood layover facility improvements will be constructed to support the overnight storage, cleaning, and light duty maintenance of the Sounder trains.

The layover yard is located in Lakewood, between Steilacoom Boulevard and South 100th Street. This contract will construct the Lakewood layover support facilities to provide wayside power, yard lighting, security, and a location for janitorial and maintenance functions.
