PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a five year contract with Kraght Snell, P.S. to provide JDE EnterpriseOne ERP system advisory services for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$800,000.

KEY FEATURES SUMMARY

- JDE EnterpriseOne (also known as E1) is the financial system for the agency. It handles
 financial accounting, accounts payable, procurement and contracts, fixed assets, real
 estate/property management and HR/payroll functions. E1 is also integrated with the agency's
 project management system, contract management system, budget system and will be
 integrated with the enterprise asset management system when it is completed.
- Under this contract, Kraght Snell, P.S. will provide advisory services for the E1 system including:
 - Advising the agency on requirements for tracking and recording of accounting transactions and processes, identifying potential solutions and making recommendations utilizing JDE EnterpriseOne, and assisting in implementation of those solutions.
 - Advising and assisting in the accounting system set-up, including but not limited to: automated accounting instructions, chart of accounts, business units, category code utilizations for efficient utilization and reporting.
 - Providing advice and support on upgrades, tools releases, integration of other applications and troubleshooting issues.
 - Advising and assisting in reporting and data analysis support to the Accounting division and its customers.

BACKGROUND

Over the past ten years, Sound Transit has utilized consultant services to assist Sound Transit with the implementation of a number of JDE EnterpriseOne (E1) applications, along with providing advanced E1 and accounting support to the agency.

In May 2013, Sound Transit issued a new Request for Proposals (RFP) for accounting advisory services. One of the services included in the RFP was JDE EnterpriseOne ERP system advisory services. Two proposals were submitted in response to the RFP for this service; however, one firm withdrew prior to the evaluations. Evaluations were conducted on Kraght Snell, P.S.'s proposal and it was determined that the firm is qualified to provide the requested services. Kraght Snell, P.S. was therefore selected to be awarded the contract.

Experience with financial accounting, internal controls/design and system applications are required in order to adequately perform the services required in the contract. This combination of skills

makes it difficult to hire a full-time FTE equivalent. As a result, it is more practical to hire an external firm to provide these services.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding for accounting advisory services has been assumed within the agency's financial plan and within the staff budgets. There is no action outside of the Board-adopted budget; there are no contingency funds required, no subarea impacts, or funding required from other parties other than what is already assumed in the financial plan.
