PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a three-year contract with two one-year options to extend with Spectrum Design to provide grants program consultant services for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$300,000.

KEY FEATURES SUMMARY

- Under this contract, Spectrum Design will assist Sound Transit in developing competitive grant applications to help meet grant assumptions included in the agency's financial plan.
- The process of applying for and securing grants is cyclical in nature, resulting in spikes in workload and the need for additional resources and specialized expertise.
- The scope of work consists of performing specialized grant development and administration duties; and providing assistance and professional support to management and staff in a range of grant strategy, analysis and reporting activities. The contract will be utilized on an asneeded basis.
- The requested contract amount covers the three-year contract and the two one-year options.

BACKGROUND

Spectrum Design will serve as a technical consultant to Sound Transit management and staff on grant administrative and grant development issues. Duties include researching potential new grant funding sources, assisting with the technical writing of grant proposals, reviewing grant agreements and assisting in meeting the reporting requirements of grantor agencies.

Because some grant competitions happen annually, biennially, or on another cyclical schedule, it is recommended that the agency have additional resources available through a consultant and not a regular full time employee. Grant consulting services included in this contract are mainly needed when grant proposals are due and when grant agreements are executed. When there are fewer grant competitions available, consultant services are not needed.

FISCAL IMPACT

The proposed action is consistent with the current Board-adopted budget and is affordable within Sound Transit's current long-term financial plan and the subarea financial capacity.

The total requested amount for the five-year period is \$300,000, an estimated \$10,000 of the contract could be utilized in 2013. The balance will be requested in future years' staff operating budgets.
