PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute an amendment to the existing lease located at Overlake Transit Center with Pedal Dynamics, Inc. to extend the term of the lease.

KEY FEATURES SUMMARY

- Pedal Dynamics, Inc. leases 250 square feet of space from Sound Transit for bicycle repair and storage space. The current lease expires January 31, 2014.
- The tenant is paying current market rate. Rent is increased annually based on the Consumer Price Index.
- Lease will be extended until the property is needed for construction and a 30 day notice to terminate is given.
- All other terms and conditions of the lease will remain unchanged.
- This lease agreement is not in conflict with any other agreements that have been executed regarding the Overlake Transit Center.
- The original lease was signed under the CEO's signing authority. Leases in excess of five years require Board approval per Board Resolution 78-2.

BACKGROUND

Sound Transit owns an office building at the Overlake Transit Center. Pedal Dynamics has leased 250 square feet of space since February 1, 2009. The leased building will be demolished in order to construct a parking garage at the site for the East Link Extension.

Sound Transit anticipates awarding a design-build contract for Overlake Transit Center construction in the first quarter of 2015. The actual start of construction will be determined in consultation with the contractor. This action will extend the term of the lease until the property is needed for construction.

FISCAL IMPACT

Lease revenues are included within the miscellaneous revenues the agency receives. The Pedal Dynamics, Inc. annual lease revenue of \$4,908 is included within the adopted 2014 miscellaneous revenues budget of \$10.7 million.
