Contract for Federal Relations Consulting Services

PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a one-year contract with two one-year options to extend with McBee Strategic Consulting, LLC to provide federal relations consulting services for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$1,483,632.

KEY FEATURES SUMMARY

- McBee Strategic will provide federal relations consulting services through frequent consultations with Sound Transit and interactions on behalf of the agency with the federal legislative and executive branches of government.
- The amount requested is sufficient to cover the one-year contract and the two option years to extend. Following the first year of the contract, staff will determine whether to exercise an option year or procure a new contract for these services. The costs reflect a \$40,000 monthly retainer for the services of the firm.
- Sound Transit's current federal relations consulting contract will expire on December 31, 2014.

BACKGROUND

Federal relations consulting services will provide the agency with strategic planning and coordination in the development and implementation of a comprehensive federal strategy. The scope of the contract covers support for securing annual appropriations, federal approvals and assisting in the definition and promotion of the agency's interests with the executive and legislative branches, including the reauthorization of federal transportation programs, and development and implementation of federal funding strategies.

To assist the agency in achieving its federal agenda, Sound Transit has retained the services of federal relations consulting firms since the agency was formed. Sound Transit has been successful in achieving federal-level goals, including having secured two Federal Transit Administration (FTA) New Starts grants for the construction of light rail between downtown Seattle and the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (\$500 million) and the extension to the University of Washington (\$813 million).

The agency's federal agenda for 2015 is significant to help ensure the agency achieves its federal funding assumptions over time. In 2015, Sound Transit will be seeking Engineering Authority from the FTA for the light rail extension to Lynnwood, as part of the New Starts process leading to a Full Funding Grant Agreement. In addition, Sound Transit will be working on a Small Starts Grant Agreement for the extension of Tacoma Link, a critical funding source for this partnership project with the City of Tacoma. Also in 2015, Congress will consider the reauthorization of federal transportation programs, which should include reauthorization of the New Starts/Small Starts programs.

The agency solicited proposals for federal relations consulting services in October 2014 through a competitive Request for Proposals process. Three proposals were received and evaluated, with McBee Strategic Consulting, LLC determined to be the top ranked firm offering the best value and in the best interests of Sound Transit.

FISCAL INFORMATION

McBee Strategic Consulting, LLC

The current federal relations consulting contract will expire on December 31, 2014. This action executes a one-year contract with two one-year options to extend with McBee Strategic Consulting, LLC to provide consulting services. The expected spending for the first year of \$480,000 is based on the \$40,000 monthly retainer for the services of the firm.

Small Business and DBE goals are based upon an examination of subcontracting opportunities contained in the work of this contract and the number of Small Businesses/DBEs available to perform such subcontracting work.

Sound Transit determined that Small Business and DBE subcontracting opportunities are infeasible or improbable based upon the work described in this contract, so Small Business/DBE goals were not established or required. However, McBee Strategic Consulting, LLC has committed to providing 33% of the work to Peyser Associates, LLC, which is a small business.
