- Contract Value \$500 million; 80% complete









N125 TBM Tunneling







- TBM #2 Completed tunnel to UDS – March 24, 2016
- TBM #1 Completed tunnel to UWS – March 30, 2016
- Refurbished TBM #1
 Relaunched June 14, 2016
- Complete TBM Tunneling to UWS Aug. 30, 2016 (est.)
- Completed 36,600 LF of tunnels (200 ft to go)
- Skilled workers spent over
 1.6 million hours on the job

N125 Challenges



- Differing site conditions at cross passages
- Sinkhole @ 12th Avenue NE
- Noise & vibration on campus due to tunneling
- UW Football season
- Schedule Milestones handover to station contractors

Contract Procurement



Four contracts bid and awarded since April

- All contracts Design-Bid-Build (D-B-B)
- Received 4 bids on each contract
- 3 of 4 low bids less than Engineer's Estimate
- Total amount of 4 contracts \$250 million









Demolition at Northgate and U District



- Contract Amount: \$2.7 Million
- Provide space for parking & CM office



115kV Transmission Line Relocation I-5 ROW Near Northgate





- Contract with Potelco, Inc.
- Notice to Proceed: June 2016
- Contract Amount: \$2.8 Million
- Move power lines from 1st Ave NE to I-5 ROW



Trackwork for Entire Northgate Extension



- Contract with Stacy & Witbeck
- Contract Awarded: July 2016
- Contract Amount: \$71.5 Million
- Provides all Northgate Link track, including noise and vibration mitigation



Northgate Station, Elevated Guideway and Parking Garage



- Contract with Absher Construction
- Contract approval: August 2016 (on today's Board agenda)
- Contract amount: \$174 Million
- Significant features:
 - elevated guideway & station with transit island at street level
 - 450-stall partially below-grade parking garage
 - pedestrian and bicycle access improvements



Third Party Agreements



- Northgate property settlement agreement King County Metro
 - ST acquires land and temporary easements for station construction
 - ST will build bus improvements and bus layover facility for KCM
 - ST will assume management of SPG parking garage lease in 2021
 - Board review December
- Northgate pedestrian and bike improvement funding MOA City of Seattle
 - ST funding contribution for SDOT's ped bridge and 1st Ave NE protected bike lane projects
 - Board review November
- Northgate transmission line relocation cost-sharing MOA City Light
 - If required in future
 - Board review November



Top Risks – Northgate Link



- Differing site and underground conditions
- Multiple contract interfaces
- Construction market conditions price escalation, shortages
- Noise and vibration due to tunneling under campus
- Third party approvals City, King County, WSDOT, UW
