## PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a one-year contract with four one-year options with Shelly Brown Associates to provide administrator services for the Citizen Oversight Panel for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$345,000.

#### **KEY FEATURES SUMMARY**

- This action would provide independent administrator services for the Citizen Oversight Panel (COP).
- The COP administrator's duties include:
  - o Support and coordination with COP members and Sound Transit staff.
  - Assistance to the COP chair in staffing and facilitating meetings, developing agendas, work programs and processes, and preparing meeting summaries.
  - o Research, analysis, and development of issues identified by the COP for meetings.
  - o Drafting and revising evaluation reports, correspondence, and other written materials.
  - Attending COP presentations at Sound Transit Board meetings, committees and public groups, and participating in the presentations, as needed.
- The contract provides for a one-year term with four additional one-year options to extend. The
  requested amount is sufficient to cover all five years of the contract.

## **BACKGROUND**

The Citizen Oversight Panel's (COP) mission as an independent body is to review and provide a "report card" and recommendations to the Sound Transit Board regarding the agency's progress toward fulfilling its commitments to the public.

Sound Transit contracts with an administrator to serve as an independent staff person to the COP. The administrator works in close coordination with the COP Chair and Vice Chair and with Sound Transit staff. Having an independent staff person allows the COP to maintain their independent review of the agency's performance.

The contract is the result of a competitive Request for Proposals, which was advertised in August 2016. One proposal was received. Following an evaluation, Shelly Brown Associates was selected as the firm offering the best value to Sound Transit.

## FISCAL INFORMATION

This contract with Shelly Brown Associates will take effect on January 1, 2017.

This action is within the proposed 2017 budget and sufficient monies remain after approval of this action to fund the remaining services as contained in the proposed department budget. Budget for the future years' expenses will be requested in future annual budgets.
