PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a contract amendment with HDR Engineering, Inc. to provide professional services for Phase 3 of the Federal Way Link Extension in the amount of \$1,903,978 with a 10% contingency of \$190,398, totaling \$2,094,376, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$32,076,909.

KEY FEATURES SUMMARY

- A separate action, Resolution No. R2016-04, would restore funding to the Sound Transit 2
 Financial Plan and amend the Adopted 2016 Budget to include sufficient funds to extend
 preliminary engineering from the Kent/Des Moines Station to the Federal Way Transit Center.
- This action amends the consultant services contract for Phase 3 of the Federal Way Link Extension to complete preliminary engineering of the preferred alternative south of the proposed Kent/Des Moines Station to the Federal Way Transit Center.
- This action is not expected to affect the overall schedule of Phase 3 activities. Completion of all three phases is anticipated by late 2016.

BACKGROUND

The Federal Way Link Extension extends from the future Angle Lake Link light rail station at South 200th Street in SeaTac to the Federal Way Transit Center area in Federal Way. Currently, there is projected funding to construct to Kent/Des Moines in the vicinity of Highline College. Construction funding to the Federal Way Transit Center is a candidate ST3 project. Service to Kent/Des Moines is planned to begin in 2023.

The standard project development process has three phases. Phase 1 includes alternatives analysis and environmental scoping. Phase 2 includes the preparation of a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and conceptual engineering of alternative alignments and stations as identified through the alternatives analysis. Phase 3 includes the preparation of a Final EIS, including responses to public and agency comments on the Draft EIS, and Preliminary Engineering of a preferred alternative. All alternatives continue to be evaluated, and the Sound Transit Board makes a final decision on the project to be built after completion of the Final EIS.

A decision to identify a preferred alternative for the Federal Way Link Extension was part of Motion No. M2015-56. A separate motion, Motion No. M2015-57, approved Phase 3 consultant services including Preliminary Engineering of the preferred alternative to the proposed Kent/Des Moines Station, and additional conceptual engineering south of the proposed Kent/Des Moines Station to the Federal Way Transit Center to support completion of environmental review.

HDR has begun Phase 3 work, including Preliminary Engineering to the Kent/Des Moines Station area, and was invited to negotiate the scope of work and cost for additional Preliminary Engineering south of the Kent/Des Moines Station to the Federal Way Transit Center. This contract

amendment approves the additional Preliminary Engineering work in the Phase 3 consultant services scope of work.

FISCAL IMPACT

This action is within the adopted budget and sufficient funds remain after approval of this action to fund the remaining work in the Preliminary Engineering Phase as contained in the current cost estimates.

A separate action, Resolution No. R2016-04, would amend the Adopted 2016 Budget to include sufficient funds to extend preliminary engineering from the Kent/Des Moines Station to the Federal Way Transit Center.

The 2016 Lifetime Budget for the Federal Way Link Extension is \$48,790,000 including the pending Budget Amendment. Within that amount, \$33,329,000 has been set aside for the Preliminary Engineering Phase. Out of that amount \$30,286,041 has been committed for the Preliminary Engineering Phase.

The proposed action would commit \$2,094,376 for the HDR Engineering, Inc. contract totaling to \$32,076,909 leaving the remaining uncommitted budget of \$948,580 in the Preliminary Engineering Phase.

SMALL BUSINESS PARTICIPATION

Sound Transit promotes and encourages small business participation, which also includes Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs). Consistent with Sound Transit Policies and Federal

Regulations, Sound Transit has established Small Business/DBE goals for this contract. These goals are based upon an examination of subcontracting opportunities contained in the work of this contract and the number of Small Businesses/DBEs available to perform such subcontracting work.

For this specific contract, the following goals were set and the successful Bidder/Proposer has committed to the following Small Business/DBE Participation:

Small Business Goals
Sound Transit Goal: 18%

Committed Goal: 18% (over the life of the contract through Phase 3)

To date, HDR has achieved 20% participation for Phases 1 and 2. Seventeen percent participation is anticipated for Phase 3 work.

TIME CONSTRAINTS

A one-month delay in approval of this action would delay the completion of preliminary engineering from the Kent/Des Moines Station to the Federal Way Transit Center.

A motion of the Board of the Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority authorizing the chief executive officer to execute a contract amendment with HDR Engineering, Inc. to provide professional services for Phase 3 of the Federal Way Link Extension in the amount of \$1,903,978 with a 10% contingency of \$190,398, totaling \$2,094,376, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$32,076,909.

BACKGROUND:
