Summary: 2016 boundary update

- The last Sound Transit boundary update was May, 2013.
- This action is in preparation for an anticipated November 2016 Sound Transit vote
- General boundary update:
 - incorporates annexations in Bellevue, Issaquah, Renton and Sammamish
 - General boundary reference clarifications
- Minimal impact.
 - These annexations add approximately 78 acres to the district
 - Annexed areas include public property, vacant land and church facilities

Annexations to the RTA

- Since 2010, when cities inside the RTA annex areas outside the district, these areas annex to both the City and the RTA.
- Since 2013, the following areas have annexed to the RTA:
 - (1) Bellevue (Lakemont Blvd. SE Right of Way)
 - (2) Issaquah (McCarry Woods)
 - (3) Renton (Maertins)
 - (4) Sammamish (Klahanie (partial))



Updating the boundary

- In some cases, some boundary references were refined for clarity.
- The proposed legal description has been shared with the Elections and Assessor departments for King, Pierce and Snohomish Counties.
