# Ratify a Contract Amendment for Information Technology Equipment and Software

### PROPOSED ACTION

Ratifies a contract amendment with Softchoice Corporation to provide technology hardware, software, peripherals, software licenses, and maintenance services through January 2017, in the amount of \$20,000 for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$520,000.

#### **KEY FEATURES SUMMARY**

- The additional \$20,000 will allow Sound Transit to pay a final invoice for a Vulnerability
  Management software subscription through August 2017. The software was purchased through
  Softchoice to provide Sound Transit with a network vulnerability monitoring application offered
  by Qualys, Inc.
- The original contract was executed under the CEO's authority in the amount of \$197,100, and was previously amended by the Operations and Administration Committee in 2015 to increase the contract to \$500,000 to cover procurement needs through January 2017.
- Sound Transit uses the Softchoice contract to:
  - purchase technology peripherals such as digital cameras, power supplies, hard drives, memory, Apple products, tablets, etc.;
  - o procure software licenses and maintenance renewals for hardware and software; and
  - purchase new hardware for approved agency projects for Sound Transit FTEs and consulting staff.

#### BACKGROUND

Softchoice has been providing the agency with these services for the past three years and the contract ratification will provide authority to remit on the invoice for the Qualys, Inc. network vulnerability monitoring application.

The federal Cooperative Purchasing Program allows authorized State and local government entities access to information technology items offered under U.S. General Services Administration's (GSA) Schedule 70.

Sound Transit currently uses a GSA contract with Softchoice Corporation to provide agency-wide technology hardware, software, peripherals, software licenses and maintenance services at all facilities. Use of the GSA Softchoice contract provides a 15% to 30% discount.

### FISCAL INFORMATION

The proposed action seeks to add \$20,000 in additional contract authority to Softchoice Corporation to purchase technology hardware, software, licenses and maintenance services.

Funding for this contract ratification will come from the IT staff operating budget and is included in the 2017 adopted budget.
