PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a contract amendment with Envirolssues, Inc. for public involvement consultant services in the amount of \$45,000 for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$1,405,000.

KEY FEATURES SUMMARY

- Envirolssues, Inc. provided public information and public involvement consultant services to support the Board in shaping the Sound Transit 3 (ST3) ballot measure, including developing web content and interactive features to show transit options and benefits.
- This amendment will provide funding to migrate and assimilate website content highlighting ST3 projects with information about previously approved agency projects.
- Staff has determined adapting the existing interactive map structure developed under this contract with Envirolssues, Inc. will be the most cost-effective and expedient option, providing continued public benefits from earlier work.

BACKGROUND

In August 2013 Sound Transit entered into a contract with Envirolssues, Inc. to promote widespread public interest and involvement as the Board shaped the future of the regional transit system.

The contract scope of work included developing a website for the Sound Transit 3 measure that included an interactive map that provides an accessible public interface to information about projects.

Prior to closure of this contract, work under this amendment will maintain and preserve elements of the ST3 website as information about Sound Transit 3 projects is merged with information about previously approved projects.

Envirolssues, Inc. was selected through a competitive procurement process. A request for proposals was issued on May 20, 2013. Of the five proposals received and evaluated, Envirolssues, Inc. was ranked the highest by the selection team and determined to be the best value for Sound Transit.

FISCAL INFORMATION

This action is within the authorized project allocation to date and sufficient funds remain after approval of this action to fund the remaining work in the preliminary engineering phase.

The authorized project allocation to date for ST3 Planning is \$52,648,024. Within that amount \$5,204,950 has been allocated for public outreach activities in the preliminary engineering phase. The proposed action would commit an additional \$45,000 to the Envirolssues, Inc. contract to provide consultant services to update the current interactive map and support the Agency's efforts to move remaining content from soundtransit3.org to soundtransit.org leaving the remaining uncommitted budget of \$27,984,878 in the preliminary engineering phase.

<u>Motion No. M2013-63</u>: Authorized the chief executive officer to execute a three-year contract with two one-year options to extend with Envirolssues, Inc. to provide public involvement consultant services for planning the next phase of high-capacity transit system development for a total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$800,000.
