PROPOSED ACTION

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a five-year contract with ten one-year options to extend with Cornerstone OnDemand, Inc. to provide Cornerstone Learning for the Learning Management System Software in the amount of \$245,000 plus applicable taxes.

KEY FEATURES SUMMARY

- The action will authorize a contract with Cornerstone OnDemand, Inc. to provide Cornerstone Learning for the Learning Management System Software.
- Sound Transit's current Learning Management System (LMS) has reached the end of its contract term and no longer meets some of the requirements of the agency.
- Sound Transit is seeking a comprehensive LMS that will fully support both the agency's training and compliance certification programs as the workforce grows to meet the system expansion demands. The new LMS is not only essential to the Sound Transit's organizational and employee development efforts, but is a critical component in supporting Sound Transit compliance with Federal and State transit and safety regulations.
- The requested amount covers application hosting, implementation, deployment, customer support, maintenance and upgrades for the initial five year term. Staff will return to request additional funding for the options, if exercised.
- Applicable taxes are currently estimated to be \$24,745.

BACKGROUND

Sound Transit requires a new Learning Management System (LMS) Solution. This comprehensive LMS will support both agency training and compliance certification programs as the workforce grows to meet the system expansion demands. The new LMS is not only essential to Sound Transit's organizational and employee development efforts, but is a critical component in supporting Sound Transit compliance with federal and state transit and safety regulations.

Sound Transit's new LMS will have the capability to serve two distinct user audiences—Sound Transit employees and contract/consultant resources. The LMS user experience will be separate for each of the groups, but the content will be easily be shared behind the scenes for administration.

PROCUREMENT INFORMATION

Prior to issuing the solicitation for the Learning Management System, Sound Transit considered the project scope, the determining factors for contract award, and the need for proposal discussions and revisions, determining that a Request for Proposals procurement method was the most advantageous. Sound Transit advertised Request for Proposals No. RTA/RP 0147-17 on August 31, 2017. Sound Transit received 6 proposals in response to the solicitation. On

October 18, 2017, Sound Transit requested revised proposals from the top three firms in the competitive range.

Sound Transit's evaluation team determined that Cornerstone OnDemand Inc.'s proposal is the response that best meets the evaluation criteria, offered the best value and is in the best interest of Sound Transit.

FISCAL INFORMATION

The Cornerstone on Demand Inc., contract will receive funding from both capital and operating budgets. In the current year, the Information Technology Program will fund \$59,600 plus applicable taxes. The Finance and Information Technology (FIT) Department will fund the remaining contract amounts for future years. Funding for the additional years of the contract will be included in subsequent annual budgets submitted to the Board.

The authorized project allocation to date for the Information Technology Program is \$35,135,942. Within that amount \$23,189,430 has been allocated to the administrative capital phase. The proposed action would commit \$59,600 plus applicable taxes to this line item and leave a remaining phase budget of \$4,269,619.
