


Agency Mission

2007

- Sustainability Initiative adopted by the Sound Transit Board
- Executive Order No. 1 issued by the CEO to implement the Sustainability Initiative
- Environmental and Sustainability Management System ISO 14001 certified (recertified 2010, 2013 & 2017)
- First set of Annual Sustainability Targets developed

2011

 First Sustainability Plan approved

2015

- 2015 plan update approved
- Received Platinum recognition for APTA's Sustainability Commitment

2016

Sound Transit 3 passes, including dedicated green building and infrastructure, sustainability, access and Transit Oriented Development funding 2019

2019 plan update approved




2019 – Why Update?

All staff champion sustainability	Certify key staff to green design and building management professional accreditations
	Develop program for agency staff to research new sustainability solutions

Long-term (2050) Goals	Example short-term (2024) goals
Achieve carbon free operations - Electricity (facilities & light rail) by 2030 - All fleets by 2050	Determine battery electric bus feasibility for ST bus services
	Purchase available cost-effective, carbon-free electricity
	Reduce total greenhouse gas emissions by 10% against 2017 baseline
Enhance ecosystem functions	Include green methods or features in at least 75% of all new procurements
	Establish corridor-specific resource conservation goals for capital projects



PROSPERITY

Long-term (2050) Goals	Example short-term (2024) goals
Build resilience to climate change and natural disasters	Complete tri-county Threat Hazard Identification Risk Analysis and publish a Hazard Mitigation and Response Plan
	Conduct a Climate Resilience Assessment as part of each major system capital expansion project
Maximize operational efficiency	Implement sustainable design guidelines and processes for renovation projects
	Achieve paperless processes for agency procurements and HR practices
