Proposed action

Authorizes the chief executive officer to execute a contract modification with LTK Engineering Services, LLC to provide light rail vehicle engineering and inspection consultant services for the Hilltop Tacoma Link Extension in the amount not to exceed \$1,816,194, with a 10 percent contingency of \$181,619 totaling \$1,997,814, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$19,981,033, contingent upon Board approval of Resolution No. R2020-12.

Key features summary

- The proposed action modifies the contract with LTK Engineering Services, LLC to provide inspection
 and commissioning services for five light rail vehicles (LRV) needed for the Hilltop Tacoma Link
 Extension (HTLE). This action was planned and included in the HTLE baseline scope and budget.
- This modification provides funding for LRV engineering reviews, inspection and commissioning services for the Hilltop Tacoma LRVs during manufacturing and commissioning of the vehicles. Previous modification provided funding for LTK's services during the development of technical specifications, procurement of the LRV manufacturer contract, and during design of the Hilltop Tacoma vehicles.
- The requested amount includes engineering and inspection services through the manufacturing, commissioning and final acceptance of the five Tacoma LRVs. Commissioning and Conditional Acceptance of the five LRVs is anticipated to be completed by 2Q 2022, to support the revenue service date of May 2022.

Background

The Hilltop Tacoma Link Extension is a 2.4 mile extension of light rail from the Theater District in downtown to the Hilltop neighborhood in Tacoma. The extension will travel at-grade, in-street with traffic along Stadium Way, North 1st Street, Division Avenue, and Martin Luther King Jr. Way. The project includes six new stations, relocates the Theater District Station, expands the existing Tacoma Operations and Maintenance Facility (OMF), and provides for additional light rail vehicles.

Revenue service for the extension is forecast for May 2022.


Tacoma Link currently operates three light rail vehicles along the existing 1.6-mile alignment. The new fleet of vehicles will provide the additional capacity required to support the Hilltop Tacoma Link Extension.

In April 2016, the Board approved the planned contract amendment to exercise the option for LTK Engineering, LLC services contract to include the Tacoma Link vehicles procurement. The scope of the modification included support for preparation of the final contract documents, vehicle specifications, report, schedules and cost estimates for the five new vehicles. Staff proposed to add the inspection and commissioning services at a later date when there would be certainty regarding whether the car builder would be a domestic or international manufacturer. The contract to design and manufacture the Tacoma Link vehicles was awarded to Brookville Engineering Corporation, a domestic business, in December 2017.

The current Hilltop Tacoma Link Extension project budget includes the services in this action.

This action will increase the contract amount to provide inspection and commissioning services for the Brookville vehicles being manufactured by Brookville.

Procurement information

A Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for procurement of the ST2 Light Rail Vehicles (LRV) Engineering and Inspection Consultant Services, which included an option for the Tacoma Link vehicles was issued in January 2014. Sound Transit received four Statement of Qualifications on February 25, 2014. Sound Transit reviewed and evaluated the Statements of Qualifications per the criteria in the RFQ.

LTK was determined to be the highest ranked firm based on qualifications, and was invited to enter into negotiations for a fair and reasonable price. On July 24, 2014, contract RTA/AE 0183-13 was executed to provide engineering and inspection services to support the purchase of new light rail vehicles. After approval by the Board in April 2016, the contract was modified to exercise a contract option to add LTK services for the Tacoma Link vehicles, and included funding for the services during the development of technical specifications, procurement of the vehicle manufacturer contract, and during design of the Hilltop Tacoma vehicles. This action adds funding for the final phases of inspection and commissioning of the vehicles. Negotiations have been initiated and a price not to exceed amount of this action has been determined to be fair and reasonable.

Fiscal information

This action is within the baseline budget and sufficient monies remain after approval of this action to fund the remaining work in the vehicles phase.

The baseline budget for the Hilltop Tacoma Link Extension is \$252,746,000. Within the vehicles phase, \$3,050,000 has been allocated to LTK Engineering Services for light rail vehicle engineering and inspection consultant services. The action would commit \$1,997,814 to this line item and leave a budget balance of \$29,688.

A one-month delay could impact the project schedule by limiting consultant services providing agency oversight of the light rail vehicle manufacturer.
