Here we go again. This line in M2024-71 is morally unacceptable:

"The Sound Transit Board asks that the Legislature partner with Sound Transit in combatting transportation emissions in the Puget Sound by eliminating the prohibition on competing for state grant funds."

We've had this discussion before. We seem to need to have it again.

Sound Transit has unique revenue tools that no other transit in this state has. You are not asking to give us those same revenue tools, while going after the small state grant funds pots and not working to expand the funds.
