Authorized Allocation (lifetime) for all active project costs, including past actuals. Includes system expansion and service delivery projects.


Long-Range Financial Plan (2017 – 2046) Board Updated

FY 2025 overview – revenues and sources






- Tax revenues: Economic growth expected to pick up regionally after slow 2024
- Fares: Full year of Lynnwood and Starter Line; opening of Downtown Redmond and East Link
- Grants: Lower Lynnwood funding due to project opening and reduced costs budgeted for Federal Way in 2025
- TIFIA: East Link, Lynnwood, and Downtown Redmond loan drawdowns



FY 2025 overview – uses of funds





- Expansion Projects: Growth in Stride, Ballard, West Seattle; projects in construction ramp down.
- Modal Ops: Full year of Lynnwood, Starter Line; opening of Downtown Redmond, East Link.
- Service Projects: Fund agency critical state of good repair, enhancement, and admin projects.
- Debt service: Interest begins with drawdown of East Link, Lynnwood, and Downtown Redmond TIFIA loans.



Project Management Information System*

- Project data management and reporting
- Streamline processes and leverage automated workflows
- Ensure consistent application of project tools across agency
- Increase to 2025 budget from October Board presented
 - 2025 annual project budget \$9.1M
 - 2025 annual licensing costs (under the "Other" category) \$1.5M
 - Total lifetime project allocation (Transit Improvement Plan) \$22.0M


Proposed 2025 Annual Budget

Budget 2025

Annual Budget refers to annual 2025 portion of a project's authorized allocation

System expansion (modal) 2025 Budget: \$1,692M






- Link share has decreased as Stride construction grows.
- Sounder annual budget growing due to S Tacoma and Lakewood Access Improvements
- ST Express: RapidRide C and D, Pac Ave, I-90 Two-Way Transit
- Tacoma Link: Hilltop Tacoma Link Ext.



Annual expenditures by phase

- Trend of decreasing construction, while property acquisition grows.
- Proposed 2025 Budget 2% increase from 2024 forecast.

OMF South


- Complete preliminary engineering.

- Early property acquisition and right of way activities.

Everett Link

- Identify delivery method.
- Continue to develop Draft EIS.





2025 Highlights: Link in construction

Federal Way Link

- Commission stations, garages, systems & end-of-line.
- System integration testing and landscaping.

East Link

- Substantial completion of civil and systems work.
- Startup and pre-revenue testing, revenue service.

NE 130th Infill


 Achieve substantial completion for both civil station finishes and systems.

Series 2 LRV

- Conditional and final acceptance for 152 car order.
- Begin manufacturing of the additional 10-car order.

Downtown Redmond

 Complete pre-revenue testing and achieve revenue service.

Sumner Kent, and Auburn

- Substantial completion of Sumner construction.
- Midpoint of construction for Kent and Auburn.

S Tacoma and Lakewood Access

- Start of final design.
- Construction for bus stop improvements associated with agreements with cities of S Tacoma and Lakewood.


- Complete 100% design.

- Continue construction at NE 145th/ I-5, UW-Bothell, and NE 185th Improvements project.
- Start construction of new contract awards
- Complete ROW acquisition and relocation.

BRT Maintenance Base

Commence construction.



Proposed Changes to Transit Improvement Plan for System Expansion Projects

Transit Improvement Plan (TIP) to 2030

Authorized Allocation (lifetime) for all active projects, including past actuals

Changes to TIP - system expansion modal

\$86M in proposed changes (not including mid-year amendments)

- Increases to allocation for preliminary engineering/ environmental review and property acquisition for projects in planning.
- Two projects to close (Mukilteo Station and Sounder Yard Expansion.)

Proposed increases- projects in planning

- Proposed TIP increases will primarily fund preliminary engineering/ environmental review and early right-of-way acquisition
- Increases to fund next major milestone (final design, baseline) are approved as mid-year budget amendments
