
Delivery Strategy What is unique about this Sounder project?

- Third-Party Delivery
 - 92% construction value delivered by city of Tacoma
- Cost Efficiency
- Risk Reduction
 - Betterment requests
 - Capped cost; adjustable scope



South Tacoma Station Selected Improvements

- ST-Delivered at Station: curb ramps, sidewalk improvements, lighting, wayfinding, PA system, expanded tactile pavers, added rail crossing protection
- City-Delivered in City ROW:
 - Priority 1: ~6 miles of bicycle facilities and sidewalks and transit stop improvements
 - Priority 2: Additional non-motorized improvements



Funding Agreement

City of Tacoma

- \$42.3M capped contribution
- All improvements complete by April 2030
- City required to submit quarterly progress reports
- City will own and maintain all the improvements it constructs



Proposed Board Motion

South Tacoma

• Authorize the CEO to execute a funding agreement with the City of Tacoma for the design and construction of non-motorized improvements in an amount not to exceed \$42,310,763.







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
