
Assault Data

From the data we have available, it appears all categories of assaults are trending lower.

- Data is gathered from Security Operations Center (SOC) reports as well as the Fare Ambassador Event Reports Log.
- In October 2023, the SOC created specific call types to ensure we were collecting data for assaults against transit workers. The data from these call types include Fare Ambassadors, Security, Facilities, and Operators, if reported to the SOC.

ASSAULT CALL TYPE	DESCRIPTION
Assault- Transit Worker-Physical	Physical contact was made
Assault- Transit Worker-Verbal	Verbal threats
Assault- Transit Worker-Physical Aggression	Physical intimidation (advancing towards the Fare Ambassador or displaying aggressive gestures)
