Motion No. M2025-19: Project Close-out

- Authorizes CEO to use an additional \$15M in contingencies to amend contracts/agreements with design, contractors and jurisdictions (Seattle, Shoreline, Mountlake Terrace, Lynnwood, & WSDOT) to close the remaining open items to achieve final permit closure.
- Continued analysis with Operations and Facilities to improve reliability of the operating systems.
- LLE staff are on schedule to transfer the project to the CDD Project Closeout team in August 2025.





Today's action:

 Motion No. M2025-19: Authorizes the chief executive officer to increase the cumulative contingency amount authorized to increase certain Lynnwood Link Extension contract and/or agreement amounts as necessary, by an amount of \$15,000,000 for a new total authorized cumulative contingency expenditure not to exceed \$30,000,000, all within the Lynnwood Link Extension approved baseline budget.







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
